









Getting Started and Using a Mobile Device

Reference Guide



Purpose: This guide shows all team members how to download, install and log in to the UKG Dimensions mobile app.



Action	Screenshot
Download and Install the UKG Dimensions App	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The app requires at least 75MB of available storage on your device, and minimum operating system requirements are iOS version 12 and above, or Android version 6. Using the UKG Dimensions mobile app requires use of SecureAuth Authenticate. 	
<p>Navigate: From your App Store or Google Play Store, search for and download the UKG Dimensions app.</p>	
Launching the app and logging in for the first time:	
1. Tap the icon to open the app.

<div>2. Type in the Tenant URL: https://adventhealth- sso.prd.mykronos.com</div> <div>or Scan the QR code:</div> <div></div> <div>Tap the Save button.</div>	
<div>3. Type your OPID and AdventHealth network password.</div> <div>If you are using your personal device, select the This is a private computer radio button.</div> <div>Tap the Sign In button.</div>

<p>4. Select the first authentication method listed, then tap Submit.</p> <p>Note: If you do not have the SecureAuth Authenticate app on your mobile device, click here to follow the instructions for SecureAuth Enrollment / Registration.</p>	
<p>5. Open the SecureAuth Authenticate app on your mobile device.</p>	
<p>6. Tap the screen to copy the Authenticate code.</p> <p>Note: Codes are single use and expire every 60 seconds.</p>

<p>7. Return to the UKG Dimensions app.</p> <p>Tap the Passcode field to paste the numeric code or use the buttons on screen to enter the code.</p> <p>Tap the Submit button.</p>	
<p>8. <u>Optional</u>: tap the button to Allow notifications.</p> <div><p>Note: Allowing notifications enables you to receive push notifications of open shifts. If you do not allow notifications when initially installing the app, navigate to your device settings to change the permissions.</p></div>

Home Page	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">The Home page is composed of tiles which display a summary of content from the different components.Tapping a tile allows you to navigate to components to perform different tasks.Additional tiles may display for Managers, Schedulers, Staffers, House Supervisors, or other key personnel.	
<p>Tapping the Main Menu icon provides an alternate way to access the different components.</p> <p>Use the My Notifications tile or the Bell icon to view alerts and notifications in the application, such as approved time off.</p>	
<p>Tapping the My Timecard tile on the Home page opens the tile. A quick glance displays exceptions on your timecard.</p> <p>Use the arrow icon to navigate to your timecard to view your punches, total worked hours for the pay period, PTO accruals and to submit punch corrections.</p>
